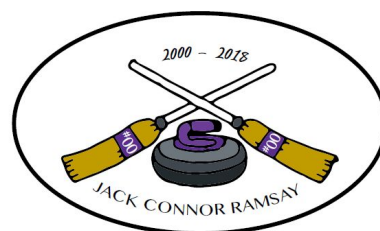




BrokerLink / Junior Slam Series Bursary



In honour of Connor Ramsay and with the generous assistance from Team Glenn Howard, the Junior Slam Series is awarding an annual monetary bursary to two deserving curling athletes.

Connor, in his brief time with us, demonstrated all the best qualities of a curling athlete. He was a positive impact on all those he played with and against and showed an unparalleled love for the game. He honoured all of the best qualities of the sport of curling and this award is given in an effort to recognize Connor's impact as a positive influence in youth curling in Ontario. Tragically, he was taken from us in the summer of 2018 as he was preparing to enter his first year of University. The bursary will be given to U21 or younger athletes that demonstrate the values that Connor so clearly displayed. These include:

- Sportsmanship both on and off the ice.
- Community involvement
- Strives for excellence both in academic and athletic pursuits
- Demonstrating a love of the sport
- Personal integrity, respect for self, competition, organizers and officials.

Two (2) bursaries will be distributed annually. One (1) female and one (1) male athlete.

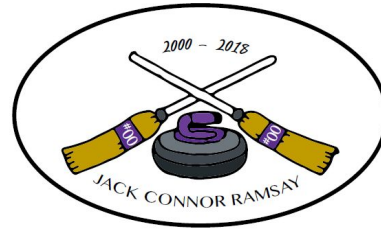
Conditions for eligibility:

- Only eligible to win once, you can apply multiple times but only can win once
- Either entering a Canadian post secondary educational institute or already enrolled in one. (Payment will not be processed until proof of enrollment is received.)
- 20 or younger as of June 30, 2018 (born after June 30, 1997)
- Must have participated in at least 2 Junior Slam Series events in the past 2 years.

How to apply:

Applicants must submit an application form along with the a recommendation letter (Maximum one page in length) from a current or former teammate describing their relationship with the applicant as well as why this individual deserves the award. Applicants must submit either a written essay (Maximum 1500 words) or video essay (Maximum 5 minutes in length) describing the following:

- Why is curling important to you?
- What are your academic and curling career aspirations?
- How would winning the Connor Ramsay bursary help support you in those career aspirations?



While not required, feel free to include things like, a favourite curling memory, a favourite Junior Slam Series memory or advice the applicant would give themselves as a younger curler.

Applicants are encouraged to be creative with their submissions but all submissions should clearly outline the points above.

Application package:

- Completed application form
- 1 Reference Letter (max 500 words)
- Personal Essay (max 1500 words)

To the winning applicant, the bursary payment is contingent on receiving proof of post secondary admittance in a Canadian Post Secondary Institute. This DOES NOT have to be a part of the application but the bursary will not be paid out until this documentation is received.

Submissions must be received no later than 12:00 a.m. EST November 23, 2018. All submissions must be emailed to: bursary.juniorlamseries@gmail.com Video submissions must be uploaded to YouTube as private videos with the link included in the email submission. The time of submissions will be based on the timestamp of the sent message. Late and incomplete submissions will not be considered. There will be no exceptions to this. All submitted applications will be evaluated by the Junior Slam Series Education Council and winners will announced January 14, 2019.

By applying for this bursary you give the Junior Slam Series permission to use your name, likeness and content of your application (including video if applicable) in promotional materials on behalf of the Junior Slam Series.
